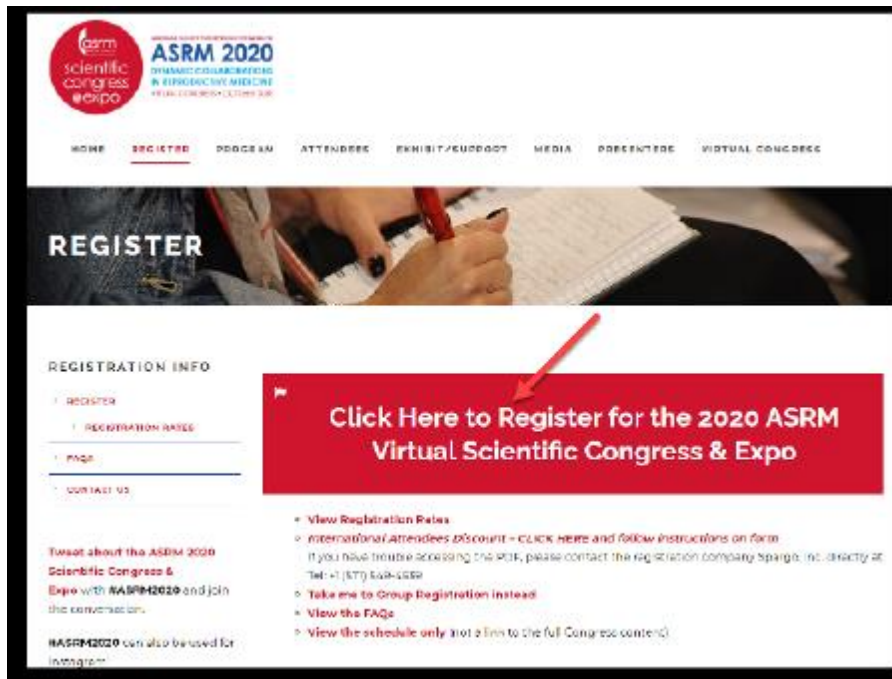


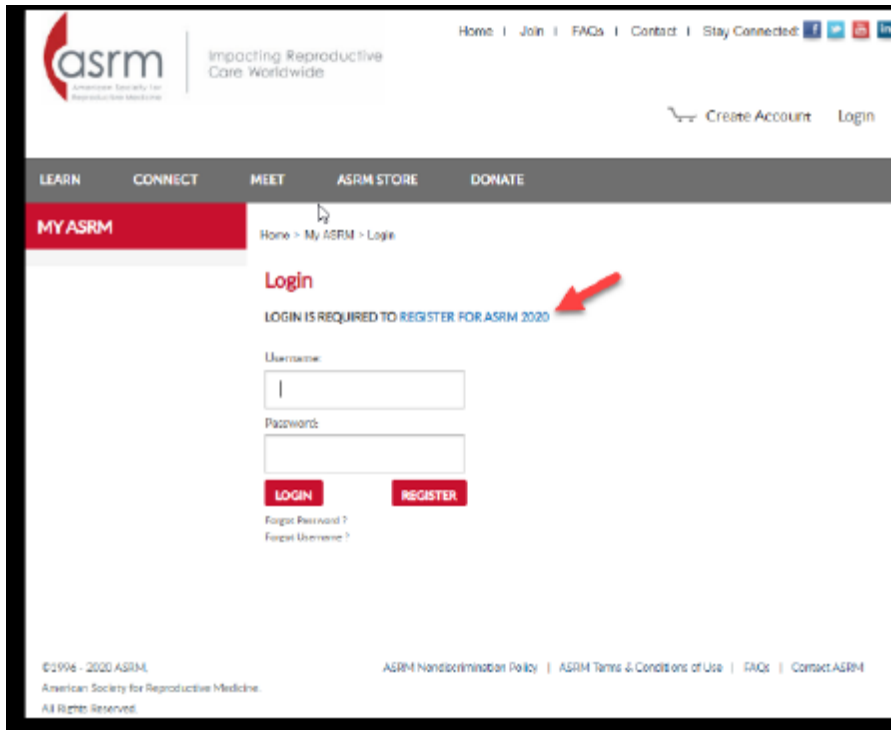


ASRM 2020 Virtual Scientific Registration Step by Step Instructions
