

Abstracts scheduled for poster presentation will be grouped by topic and program number. Your letter of notification and the Final Program will specify your poster's program number (P-___). Put your poster up on the board marked with your "P" number. All Congress times below are in local, Eastern time for Baltimore, MD.

Registration:

You must register yourself for the meeting even though you are a program participant. No discounts are offered to abstract presenters. Registration rates and program information are available here: <https://asrmcongress.org/register/>.

Poster Sessions:

Poster sessions with free continental breakfast will be held on Tuesday morning 6:30 a.m. - 7:45 a.m. and Wednesday morning 6:30 a.m. - 7:45 a.m. A Scientific Congress registration badge is required for entry to all sessions. You are expected to stand beside your poster to discuss your work with the attendees at your appointed time:

- **Poster numbers P-1 through P-402:**
 - You are scheduled to attend the Poster Presentations Session on **Tuesday, October 19, 2021 from 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 a.m.** to stand by your poster and discuss your project.
- **Poster numbers P-403 through P-803:**
 - You are scheduled to attend the Poster Presentations Session on **Wednesday, October 20, 2021 from 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 a.m.** to stand beside your poster and discuss your project.

In-Person Poster Mounting & Removal:

- Posters must be put up on the appropriate boards on **Sunday, October 17, between 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. or Monday, October 18, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Your poster should be hung no later than Monday, October 18th at 12:00 p.m. (Eastern).** A Scientific Congress badge will be required for entry, both for setup and for the Poster Session.
- Posters should be removed before **2 p.m. on Wednesday, October 20th** (when the Expo Hall closes). ASRM cannot be responsible for removing or returning posters. Posters remaining on the boards after 2 p.m. on Wednesday will be discarded.

Poster Instructions:

- **Note:** No materials advertising commercial interest, financial interest and/or other relationships with manufacturers of pharmaceuticals, laboratory supplies, and/or medical devices or with commercial providers of medically related services, or future medical meetings can be posted on the poster boards. No materials advertising society meetings can be posted on the poster boards.
- ASRM does not have a required poster template, but many can be found for free online. See poster creation service for examples.
- The poster board surface area is 4 ft **high** x 6 ft **wide** (48 inches x 72 inches/1.22 m x 1.83 m). **Minimum poster size is 3 ft x 4 ft (36 inches x 48 inches/0.91 m x 1.22 m).**

Mandatory Virtual Upload

Poster abstracts will be presented on-site **and** available in our On-Demand Congress content. You are **required** to upload a copy of your poster **and** record a short audio recording about your poster. You will receive an additional email directly from the Cadmium Poster Harvester with further instructions on uploading the copy of your poster and how to make your recording. **Note:** If an author uploads a word-only copy of the body of the abstract (meaning a copy of just the words of the abstract) instead of an actual poster, this is considered **failure to present** and ASRM's penalty for failure to present will be enacted. QR Codes:

Ideally this would include a digital version of your poster, the associated paper, and any other relevant resources. If someone would like further information after the session is over, this section should tell them the best way to do that.
